After a series of state court disputes on the recounting of ballots, the Supreme Court took on the cases of Bush v Palm Beach County Canvassing Group and of Bush v Gore (2000). CONTINGENT ELECTION House of Representatives votes by state delegation (1800, 1824)

If there is no Electoral College majority (either a 50/50 tie or no one reaches 50%)

Jefferson/Burr tie. Jefferson elected president in 1800.

In 1824, four major party candidates with no one reaching majority. Adams elected president in 1824.
